



## Executive Headteacher/CEO Programme

### Who is it for?

The programme is for Headteachers (primary or secondary) preparing for an Executive Headteacher/CEO role in the future, or for recently appointed Executive Headteachers/CEOs.

### Eligibility Criteria

Participants must:

- be suitably experienced Headteachers or senior leaders in a primary or secondary setting.
- be prepared to engage with pre reading activities and a diagnostic exercise.

### How will participants benefit?

Having completed the programme, participants will have:

- a deeper understanding of the skills, abilities and attributes needed for the role of Executive Headteacher/CEO and how these might differ from the role of Headteacher.
- learnt from the experience of existing Executive Headteachers/CEOs.
- developed a range of skills to support and strengthen their leadership of more than one school.

### What does it involve?

The programme comprises 1 twilight induction session and 1 full 'face to face' day, followed by a 'menu' of optional follow up activities which will be tailored to individual need. This may include coaching, partnership work or internship opportunities. A Twilight Review of Learning session completes the programme.

### Cost?

The programme, including access to the diagnostic tool and on-going coaching, is available at a cost of only **£500 per participant**. Additional costs may apply for certain follow up activities. If your school has a subscription to the Yorkshire Leadership Community then a discount of 10% will automatically apply.
